Health & Safety

We want everyone to have a safe and enjoyable visit. Please take a moment to read the following before you arrive.

Supervision: Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

- Wear sturdy, closed-toe footwear — the farm yard can be muddy and uneven.
- Do not climb on fences, gates, machinery, or bales.
- Keep a safe distance from all farm animals unless guided by a member of staff.
- Wash hands thoroughly after handling animals or produce.
- Do not eat or drink near the animals.
- Keep to marked paths and follow all signage on site.
- Dogs are welcome on leads but must not approach livestock.
- In the event of an emergency, call 999 and inform a member of the Aberley family immediately.
- First aid kit located in the farm office next to the Brick Barn.
